This exhibition explores the concept of gender identity, self-image, and self expression. The show includes a series of individual portraits of some of Hauser's long-time models, portrayed as themselves, rather than in the roles they usually play as actors in staged tableaus. Each of the models chose how they wished to be portrayed and the resulting portraits are an exploration of identity and self-presentation - how we see ourselves and what we choose to project to the world. While the individuality of each person is accented, the underlying text in this series, as a whole, is the shared humanity and connectivity of each life.
